


Five Rules to Ride a Bicycle Safely

1. As a rule, bicycles should travel on the road. Sidewalks are exception.

2. Bicycles should travel on the left side of the road.



3. Pedestrians have priority on the sidewalk.

Cyclists should travel slowly on the road-side of the sidewalk.



4. Cyclists must follow the traffic rules:

-Drunken riding, riding with two people on a single bicycle, riding a bicycle side by side are prohibited.

-Turn on the headlight when it's dark.

-Follow the traffic lights at the intersection, stop at a stop sign, and confirm the safety of the situation.



5. Children must wear helmets while riding bikes.
